## Welcome to Ōrewa Beach Holiday Park.



### Reception:

Open daily – 8.00am-6.30pm (Summer 8.00pm).  
Any changes will be notified at reception.

**Arrival:** Check in time is from 2pm.

### Departure:

Check-out-time no later than 10am. Please be prompt.

**Early departure:** We are not able to offer refunds or credits if circumstances or weather conditions change.

### Emergency and tsunami evacuation:

In an emergency call **111** for Police, Fire, or Ambulance.  
Report all accidents or incidents to reception.

An automated external defibrillator (AED) and first aid kit are available at reception.

Familiarise yourself and your party with both the Emergency Assembly area location, and the Tsunami Evacuation plan sign posted at the main amenities and by reception.

In the event of a tsunami, walk exiting the park, turn left up the hill following signage to the blue wave safety zone painted on footpath.

### After hours:

For late check-ins, issues or concerns that cannot wait until office hours call **0800 673 921** or **09 426 5832**.

### Camping:

Leave 1.5 metres free between site boundaries. This ensures 3 metre fire break. Campsite boundaries are marked in white paint indicators on the roadway.

All caravans must have a current Electrical Warrant of Fitness (AS/NZS3100), comply with LPG standards and provide own wastewater container. Empty black and grey wastewater in the dump station only. Camping leads must be tag tested with RCD. Please park your caravan with the towbar facing the road.

### Parking:

One vehicle only per site. Park vehicles on your own site and not on driveways or neighbouring sites. Parking on the reserve is strictly prohibited.

### Facilities:

Showers and communal amenities have hot water, please remain mindful to conserve water and energy.

Laundry machines are coin operated. Coins and laundry powder is available from reception.

**Smoking or vaping** is not allowed in any building, accommodation, kitchens, dining or BBQ communal areas and playground.



### Behaviour/conduct/noise:

Quiet time is between 10.30pm and 7am. As a guide, if you can be heard more than a site away you are too noisy.

A good standard of behaviour is expected at all times.

- Alcohol is permitted only on your site or unit. Do not walk around drinking alcohol.
- Show consideration at all times to other guests and staff.

We reserve the right to remove any person not behaving in a considerate manner without refund.

### Children:

Parents and caregivers are responsible for the safety of their children at all times. Please supervise young children at the playground.

### Drive slowly:

Speed limit 5 km/h must not be exceeded for safety being a shared area for activity.

Motorised vehicles and drivers are to Give Way to all pedestrians, bikes, pedal carts, scooters and children.

### Drones:

Drones are not allowed to be used within or over the park.

### Barbecues/Fireworks:

Open fires, coal, wood or open flame barbecues, braziers, and fireworks are prohibited.

**Pets:** Pets are **not** permitted inside building or communal shared facilities unless registered assistant dog. Under no circumstances are allowed at the south end of the park.

### Sustainability statement:

Please help to care for, to protect, and to conserve our beautiful environment and be as sustainable as possible.

- Use water and energy wisely ensuring taps, power outlets or appliances are turned off when not in use.
- Report any leaks or maintenance issues to reception.
- Sort and Recycle waste wherever possible using bins / areas provided.

### Swimming:

Always supervise children and those that are not confident swimmers. Swimming at Ōrewa Beach is usually safe, be aware the estuary and mouth have tidal currents. Check Met Service weather/tides and safeswim.org.nz before swimming and water sports.

Ōrewa Beach is patrolled by Surf Lifeguards on weekends and public holidays from Labour Weekend, October until Easter and weekday patrols December until February.

### Things to do:

Pedal carts and ping pong bats are all available from reception. Our reception can help with activity ideas, assistance, complaints and feedback.

### Visitors:

Visitors must check in at reception before entering the park and pay the daily fee. Visitors are admitted at the discretion of management at all times. Remember you are responsible for your visitors. Visitors must leave vehicles outside the park and depart before 8pm.
